



DISCIPLING QUESTIONS

OPEN UP

*Share something personal and **be known**. We engage people with relationship and conversation first.*

- What were your highs and lows last week?
- Is there a rhythm you need to begin or change?
- Pray for highs/lows, person by name.

LOOK UP

We disciple as we engage God through the Word and prayer, and discuss our spiritual lives and rhythms with others.

- What Scripture are you reading?
- What are you going to do about it? How are you fighting sin this week?
 - Think *lightbulbs*, *question marks*, *arrows*
- What verses have you memorized recently? Recite them together.
- What are you praying for?
- If you have a closer relationship, you may ask one of these questions for accountability:



Bible Reading Plan

- Was your time with God unhurried last week?
- Are you enjoying prayer?
- Are you disobedient to God in any known way?
- Is there anyone whom you fear, dislike, disown, criticize, hold a resentment toward or disregard? If so, what are you doing about it?
- Are you anxious, jealous, irritable, or critical?
- Are you expecting any person to do for you what only Jesus can? (Particularly, your spouse?)



SPEAK UP

*We speak the gospel, pray for opportunities, and ask other believers to do the same. **Live sent.***

- “How can I pray for you?” (Great starter to open the door with a stranger)
- When did you last speak to someone about your faith?
- Who are you praying for to know Christ?
 - How are you pursuing them?
- Pray for those you are pursuing by name and an opportunity to share the gospel.
- Keep an index card or a note in your phone with each person’s name, accountability needs, personal needs and concerns, and those they’re seeking to impact.





WHAT'S A **DISCIPLING** CONVERSATION?

Discipling conversations are intentional interactions where we talk openly about the important, real stuff. These conversations go beyond mere pleasantries. It's about having bold conversation, listening well, and asking good questions to help us all take our next steps with Jesus.

This simple conversation guide provides a few, easy ways to have a conversation about following Jesus. These questions can be used in a connect group, other church function, personal meeting, or group of friends.
