



GIVING

In 2023, we're eager to fund growth in our church in nearly every area. Our finance team and elders have carefully built this budget before they presented it in December 2022, based on where we hope to grow and where we see need.



What we gain from this budget:

- 1. More missions giving
- 2. More aggressive debt pay-down
- 3. Funds to meet growing attendance in our kids, youth, and college ministries
- 4. Increased part-time staffing hours
- 5. Staff access to health + retirement options
